Deck The Halls – Starter does tag ending

Winter Wonderland – Starter does tag ending

We Three Kings – Bob H. does 3 beats in between A and B; Starter does 2 beats in between each song repetition; dulcimers try to play tune on treble, middle and bass so that all 3 octaves are represented. Starter does 3 beat tag ending.

Silver Bells – Dulcimers do tag ending; at end of song walk C chord down and then up again (8 beats)

Joy To The World – Starter does 3 beats in between each song; Bass does tag ending

Let It Snow – Starter does tag ending

Rudolph – Santa stick does tag ending

Up On The Housetop/Jolly Old St Nick – ALL BACKUP players and Santa Stick do 4 beats between each Up On The Housetop song repetition, and 4 beats between the Up On The Housetop and Jolly Old St Nick transition, and 4 beats between each Jolly Old St Nick song repetition.
